Drexel Turner is assistant to the dean of the School of Architecture at Rice University.

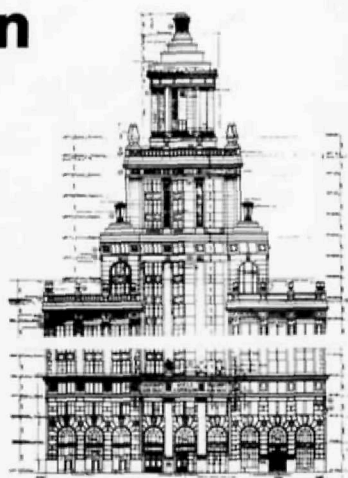
