

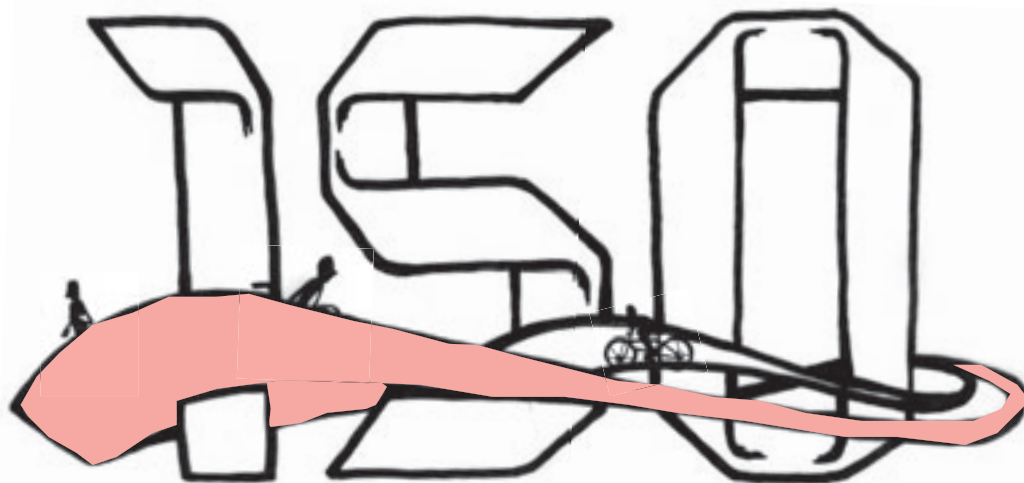

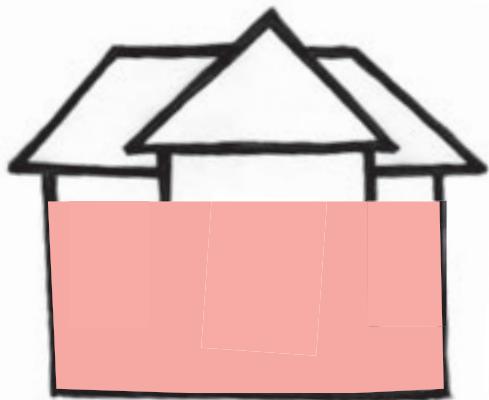
Like No Other

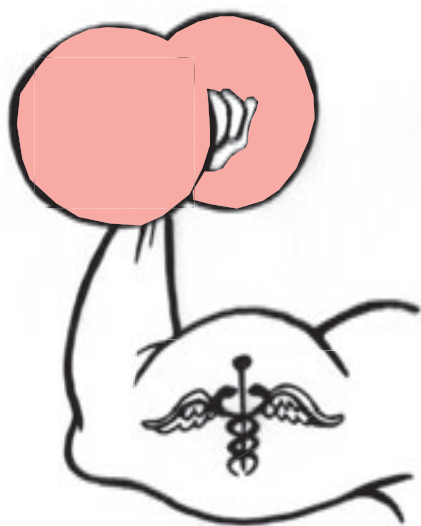
